## WE ARE HAPPY TO SERVE YOUR FAMILY!

The Church Academy in Baton Rouge (TCABR) offers an affordable private, Christian school education for your family. TCABR will continue to strive to keep tuition low and programs high, focusing on academic excellence and servant leadership.

### REGISTRATION INFORMATION

All application/processing, registration, curriculum and resource, and academic excellence fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Payment arrangements for registration, curriculum and resource, academic excellence fees, and tuition are to be setup with automatic drafts by April 30, 2018.

All payments will be made through ParentsWeb/FACTS system with Bank Account (No Fee) or Credit Card (2.85% fee per transaction). If tuition is paid in full by July 1, 2018, tuition only will be discounted by 5%.

### NEW STUDENTS

**Application/Processing Fee:** \$125 per student

**Registration Fee:** \$300 due at the time of acceptance and enrollment, \$500 after June 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Curriculum & Resource Fee:** \$250 by June 30th

**Academic Excellence Fee:** \$1000 for each NEW family. If your child was a Christian Life Academy (CLA) student at any point in their educational career, you will not have to pay the Academic Excellence Fee.

### RETURNING STUDENTS

**Reenrollment/Processing Fee:** \$20

**Re-Registration Fee:** \$150 by March 1st  
\$300 March 2<sup>nd</sup> - June 1st  
\$500 after June 1st

**Curriculum & Resource Fee:** \$250 due by June 30th

### COURSE FEES/EXTRACURRICULAR FEES

Additional fees may apply to consumables, uniform components, special texts, equipment, or other course/activity specific needs. These will be assessed after the school year begins in relation to student schedules. Applicable fees will be billed through the accounting department.

### REFERRAL INCENTIVE

Current families who refer an incoming new student to TCABR will receive a \$250.00 tuition discount for the next school year if the referred student completes the registration process, is accepted as a student, and has indicated the name of the referring family on their registration form. One referral per family.

### TUITION CREDIT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

TCABR participates in several programs that utilize the tuition credit program in Louisiana. For the 2017-2018 school year, 100 students were awarded a scholarship. To qualify you must fit the following criteria.

- \* Have a family household income that does not exceed 250% of the federal poverty guidelines, as established by the Federal Office of Management and Budget.
- \* Be a resident of Louisiana.
- \* Have attended a public school in Louisiana on October 1 and February 1 of the most recent school year; or be entering Kindergarten for the first time; or have participated in the Louisiana Scholarship Program/Tuition Donation Rebate Program for the previous school year.

### HOT LUNCH PROGRAM

Lunch program includes a hot lunch for K3 – 5th grade \$5.25 per day and 6th – 12th grade \$5.75 per day. Lunch payments will be prepaid through our FACTS/RenWeb system and are due the week before each month begins. Parents will be notified when their student has a low balance.

### CHILD CARE PROGRAMS

TCABR provides a structured, supervised, secure environment for students who must arrive early or stay late on school days. All students must be under adult supervision before or after school hours.

#### *BEFORE CARE*

Grades: PK3 students – 12th grade

Times: 6:30am – 7:30am

Cost: \$4.00 per child, per day

#### *AFTER CARE*

Grades: PK3 students – 12th grade

Times: 3:00pm – 6:00pm

Cost: \$8.00 per child, per day

Late Charges: \$1.00 per minute after 6pm

Early Dismissal Days: \$15 per child

Last Week of School: \$65 per child

#### *AFTER CARE REGISTRATION FEE*

\$20.00 per child. This one-time fee covers administrative costs and provides for needed supplies. This charge will be calculated into your first bill.

### *BILLING*

Before /After Care fees will be billed through our ParentsWeb/FACTS system weekly. A late fee of \$15.00 will be assessed to accounts that are 30 days past due.

### TCA EARLY LEARNING CENTER

TCA Early Learning Center is an educationally based mother's day out program using the ABeka curriculum for ages 6 months to 3 years old. TCA Early Learning Center hours of operation are from 9:00am to 2:00pm Monday - Thursday during normal school days (no summers or holidays). ### ATHLETIC PROGRAMS

TCABR provides a range of athletic programs for our students. Please contact the head coach of the team your student desires to join for specific information on fees and team rules. Each sport will incur a fee to cover the cost of coach's stipends, travel expenses, uniforms, athletic equipment etc.

### FACTS FINANCIAL AGREEMENT

Terms of payment for tuition and fees – The tuition rate set at the time of registration continues throughout the school year and does not change. Tuition for students registering after the first day of school will be prorated over the number of school months they will be in attendance.

1. Every family is required to be on a payment plan by April 30, 2018 with the first payment beginning in July 2018 and final payment by April 2019 using the FACTS/RenWeb system.
2. A Tuition Agreement form must be completed by April 30, 2018.
3. Families can pay monthly, bi-monthly, quarterly, or semester payments.
4. Annual Fee taken out with the first payment:  
1 or 2 payments: \$20  
3 or more payments: \$50  
Peace of Mind Insurance: \$20

## FINANCIAL COMMITMENT

The financial commitment you make to our school represents an investment in your student's education and development of faith. All families are expected during registration to select a payment plan and to remain current in their payment of tuition and fees during the year. ## REGISTRATION, CURRICULUM AND RESOURCE FEES 2018-19

All application/processing, registration, curriculum and resource, and academic excellence fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Application/Processing Fee: \$125 per new student

Reenrollment/Processing Fee: \$20 per reenrolling student

Registration for New Students: \$300 due at the time of acceptance and enrollment, \$500 after June 1<sup>st</sup>.

Registration for Returning Students: \$150 by March 1<sup>st</sup>  
\$300 from March 2<sup>nd</sup> to June 1<sup>st</sup>  
\$500 after June 1<sup>st</sup>

Curriculum & Resource Fee: \$250 due by June 30th

Academic Excellence Fee: \$1000 for each NEW Family

## ACCOMMODATION FEE

The Church Academy does not service IEPs or 504 plans but will try our best to accommodate those students that need simple classroom accommodations. The following accommodations will require the parent to pay an additional cost to cover a classroom paraprofessional that will help the teacher in accommodating the students' needs: test read aloud, shortened assignments, answers recorded, transferred answers, organizational skills, small-group testing, more one-on-one time and other accommodations that requires the use of a paraprofessional. These accommodations will be discussed with the administrator and team of teachers to see if the accommodations are necessary. If necessary, the fee is \$2000 per student.
